## The Stewardship Challenge



**Why fill out a pledge card?** True Stewardship starts by making a promise to God and holding ourselves to it. The act of filling out and submitting that pledge card solidifies that promise.

Stewardship is a deliberate, sacrificial offering, not a convenience gift where we throw what we feel comfortable with in a tray or write a check whenever we have some extra funds.

A pledge can be adjusted at any time if circumstances change, whether positive or negative.
